The Sub-National Governance (SNG) Programme is a four-year DFID funded technical assistance programme supporting the governments of Punjab and Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa as well as local governments in selected districts in both provinces, to improve the way they are governed and manage their resources for better service delivery. The objective of SNG is to further strengthen Pakistan's public financial management and planning systems, to raise more revenue and allocate money to improve basic services especially for the poor

## SNG AIMS TO DELIVER RESULTS ACROSS THE FOLLOWING MAIN AREAS:

### PLANNING AND REFORM

Improving the way the government plans and allocates resources based on evidence and helping in setting up effective systems and structures.

### BUDGETING AND TRANSPARENCY

Helping provincial and local governments manage their resources better, including better budget allocation and spending. This also includes making the process transparent and inclusive.

### FISCAL SPACE

Helping government generate and free up more resources that can be utilised for the delivery of services.

### INNOVATION AND ACTION RESEARCH

Piloting and scaling up innovative approaches to improving evidence-based policymaking, planning and financial management and action oriented research for practical solutions to governance issues.
